

Cookies Policy

In this policy you will find information on Kenny Waste Management Cookies Policy and what cookies may be set when you visit the Kenny Waste Management website as well a how to reject or delete those cookies.

What are Cookies

Cookies distinguish each individual user of our website. It is a small file of letters and number that is stored on your browser or hard drive of your device, for example, your computer or mobile phone, if you agree. This helps us to provide each visitor to our website with a good experience when they browse and allows us to improve our site. They can be used to identify you personally.

The cookies we use are 'analytical' cookies. They allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our site when they use it. This helps us to improve the way our website works, for example, be ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.

How to control & delete Cookies

Kenny Waste Management will not use cookies to collect personally identifiable information about you. However, if you wish to restrict or block the cookies which are set by our website, or indeed any other website, you can do this through your browser settings. The Help function within your browser should tell you how.

Alternatively, you may wish to visit www.aboutcookies.org which contains comprehensive information on how to do this on a wide variety of browsers. You will also find details on how to delete cookies from your computer as well as more general information about cookies. For information on how to do this on the browser of your mobile phone you will need to refer to your handset manual.

Please be aware though that restricting cookies may impact on the functionality of the Kenny Waste Management website.

Google Analytics

The Kenny Waste Management website uses Google Analytics, a web analytics service provided by Google, Inc. Google Analytics sets a cookie in order to evaluate your use of our website and compiles reports for us on activity.

Google stores the information collected by the cookie on servers in the United States. Google may also transfer this information to third parties where required to do so by law, or where such third parties process the information on Google's behalf. Google will not associate your IP address with any other data held by Google. By using our website, you consent to the processing of data about you by Google in the manner and for the purposes set out above.
